

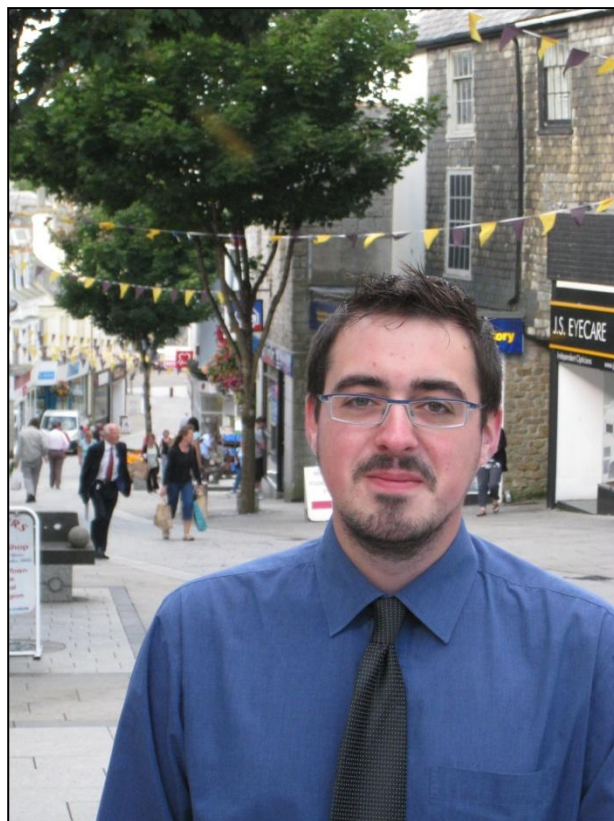
Redruth Town Development Manager First in Cornwall

Redruth's first Town Development Manager, Lee Dunkley, has just started work and this unique post, funded by the Town Council and Unlocking Cornish Potential, is believed to be the first in the County.

Lee's role is to help groups of residents, volunteers and traders to work together to achieve changes to improve the Town. He will be moving forward the 'task and finish' groups which are now working on improving the look of two derelict sites in the centre of Redruth, and on helping to promote the town.

Lee has worked both in a finance department and as a researcher for local government for a number of years. Previously working with Children and Young People, Lee is now working alongside CPR Regeneration and other partners to renew Redruth town centre.



The Town Development Manager is also the first point of contact for publicising existing events in Redruth and developing new festivals, exhibitions, collections, shows and celebrations which take place in Redruth.
