## Murdoch Day 2010 Issue

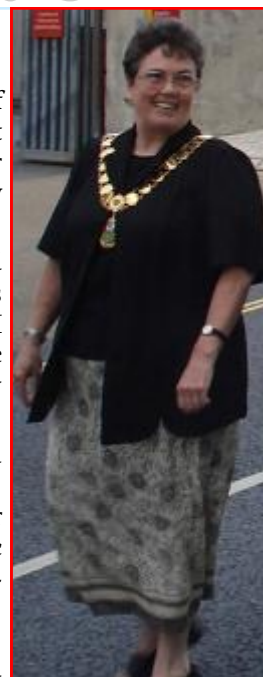
### Foreword by the out-going Town Mayor, Cllr Barbara Ellenbroek

Action Plan Project (RAPP) and explore ways of engaging with and improving neighbourhoods; creating youth activities; reducing anti-social behaviour; revitalising and improving accessibility to the Town and Parish.
