- Anything else that makes an interesting story.

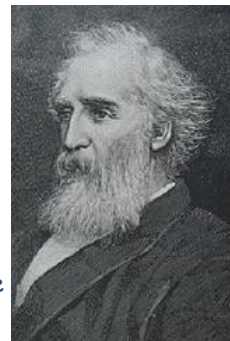

- There are no age limits associated with being an author.
- The author is responsible for accuracy and obtaining permissions of people involved in the story. The author retains the copyright to the story.
- The author's details will be retained by the Passmore Edwards working group and will not be shared with any third parties. The author agrees for the story to be retained by the Passmore Edwards working group for possible inclusion in any future publications.
- The editorial teams will select stories for publication in the first book.
- The Passmore Edwards working group determine the final content of the publication.
