### **Commitment to achieving Net Zero**

Redruth Community Association is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

## **Baseline Emissions Footprint**

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

(Each tonne of waste incinerated typically releases between <b>0.7</b> and <b>1.7</b> tonnes of CO2. This includes emissions	

	of both fossil CO2 (e.g. from burning plastics) and biogenic CO2 (e.g. from burning wood, paper and food). <i>Source Zerowasteeurope.eu</i> 6. <u>Business Travel:</u> There is no business travel related to the centre so emissions are <b>Zero.</b>

# **Emissions reduction targets**

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

Scope 1: We will seek funding to change from a gas powered heating system to an electric system.

Scope 2: We will seek to reduce our electricity usage by seeking funding to change all our lighting to LED from current fluorescent and high voltage external lighting

Scope 3: We will introduce recycling to the centre to reduce the amount of waste going to landfill.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to **4.8** tCO<sub>2</sub>e by 2026 This is a reduction of **17**%

### **Declaration and Sign Off**
