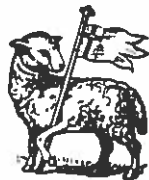

Cllrs Biscoe and Mrs Biscoe declared an interest in application PA18/01435 at serial number 950 of Item 6 on the Agenda and signed accordingly.

Mr Bolitho spoke in relation to PA18/01435 and expressed concerns about College Lane. Mr Bolitho stated that vehicles were already regularly left out on the road and that, owing to its narrowness, only one car at a time could pass through. If a vehicle was parked opposite his house, Mr Bolitho was unable to enter or exit his property. In addition, he stated that the location of the cricket club at the end of the lane meant that at times there was chaos. Mr Mitchell spoke as the applicant in relation to PA18/01435. He stated that planning permission for five houses had already been granted and that as part of the development the road would be widened. Mr Mitchell advised that each of the houses

would have two parking spaces and vehicles would be able to reverse onto their own properties and then exit in a forward gear. Mr Jordan also spoke in relation to PA18/01435 and advised that existing problems would be exacerbated with an increase of, in reality, up to twenty additional vehicles and that residents did not want to see any more houses being built. He stated that residents had not been made aware of the application and that at the moment the area was a nice, safe place to live but it was getting busier and busier. Cllr Tremayne confirmed that it was the responsibility of Cornwall Council to notify residents of neighbouring properties. Mr Mayou spoke as the architect in relation to PA18/01620 and advised that he would be happy to answer any questions.

Ms Kitchen spoke as the developer in relation to PA17/11982. She advised that a site meeting had now taken place between the developer, architect, Cornwall Council planning officer and Cllr Thomas. As a result of concerns raised by the Town Council and others, the plans had been redrawn. Changes included lowering the height of the ridges, reducing one house to a two-bedroom dwelling, reducing the wall to the side of the development to its original length to create better access, creating additional parking and removing the wall to the front of the properties, rebuilding it with the existing stones further back. The preferred access route was 3.9m wide allowing good emergency vehicle access. Ms Kitchen advised that there were currently eight garages being used on a daily basis and eighteen in use in total. Four were used for classic cars and six for storage meaning that there would be no vehicle displacement from these garages.
