



REDRUTH TOWN COUNCIL CASUAL VACANCY – REDRUTH (SOUTH) WARD

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 89(6) of the Local Government Act 1972 that a Casual Vacancy exists in the office of Councillor for the South Ward of Redruth Town Council.

Therefore, in accordance with Rule 8(3) of the Local Elections (Parish and Community) Rules 1986, the Town Council must now co-opt a suitably qualified person to serve as a Councillor for the aforementioned Ward.

Any person wishing to be considered for co-option should contact Town Council (see details below) requesting an application form.

Persons eligible for consideration must be aged 18 years or over, and

- a. is registered as a local government elector for the parish of Redruth; OR
- b. has during the whole of the preceding twelve months, occupied as owner or tenant, any land or other premises in the parish; OR
- c. your only place of work during the preceding twelve months has been in the parish; OR
- d. you have during the whole of the preceding twelve months resided in the parish or within 4.8 km (3 miles) thereof.

You are ineligible to stand as a councillor if you have, during the last five years, either been given a prison sentence of three or more months (including suspended); or have been declared bankrupt; or have been disqualified under the Representation of the People Act 1983 (which covers corrupt or illegal electoral practices and offences relating to donations) or under the Audit Commission Act 1998

The closing date for the receipt of applications is Monday 19th September 2022.
